21st Century Learning Happens Here

After going through the information above, you have likely realized something special is happening here and that we are quite different from a traditional education programme. [Here is an article](#) from Forbes that explains what 21st Century Learning is.

The focus is on skill development over information regurgitation: process over content. Content is viewed as the vehicle on the road to developing mastery in important skills, such as: critical thinking, resolving conflict, problem solving, and project management.

Thankfully we are not relying on “curriculum development”, as it happens in traditional schools, where a committee of government-appointed people discuss how to change the curriculum.

It is not surprising that this method means that curriculum only changes over decades in complete opposition to our fast-paced technologically-driven society. We are able to keep up to those changes!



Our Learning Design in Action

You won't find grades or report cards at our school. Our learners and educators use a software program unique to Acton Academy to deliver learning challenges, mediate planning, track progress, and provide feedback- all in real time.

To get a better idea of how our programme is organized, take a look at [our calendar](#). Note that it is different from a traditional school year, so please read over it to see if it works with your family. Our year is broken up into sessions, which are periods of time where we focus on one big collaborative project (called a Quest), with periods of rest so our learners can recharge and be ready for the next big adventure. Camps are often available during these breaks.

Each session is devoted to a collaborative experiential project called a Quest.
